AT UNITED WE, WE KNOW CHANGE CAN BE SLOW AND INCREMENTAL. WE ALSO KNOW THAT TRULY MOVING THE NEEDLE FOR WOMEN IS A LONG-TERM PROCESS THAT REQUIRES SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENT IN RESEARCH, ADVOCACY, AND PROGRAMMING.

2023 was a year of launching new initiatives to push the needle for all women. In addition to producing four evidence-based research studies, influencing four policy actions, and empowering 20 women to serve on a board or commission, we also developed new ways for individuals to work toward gender equity.

Partnership with the National Association of Women Business Owners (NAWBO)

Our collaboration with NAWBO brought together thousands of women throughout the
year. Together, we hosted two educational webinars highlighting advocacy and childcare.
We produced a <u>five-part audio vignette series</u> that featured key expertise from both
organizations to provide short, inspirational segments. Our partnership is poised to grow
in 2024.

Commission on Childcare and Women's Entrepreneurship

We convened dozens of experts and influential leaders nationwide to help solve the
childcare crisis. The nonpartisan Commission is generating new policy ideas about childcare
that are limiting women's entrepreneurial risk-taking. Informed by national qualitative and
quantitative research, the group will produce a report in 2024 with recommendations for
the public and private sectors.

Appointments Project LIVE!

This quarterly virtual discussion is our latest way of convening, connecting, and celebrating
women. Regardless of where they were on their civic leadership journey, women from
across the nation joined the conversation led by exceptional women in various leadership
roles for inspiration and education.

In 2024, we implement a new three-year strategic plan to further our innovative efforts. The plan focuses on three key strategies: building a national network, demonstrating thought leadership, and delivering on-demand programming. Our priorities include the launch of the United WE Institute in Washington, DC in June, and the expansion of the Appointments Project® to empower women in towns and cities across the U.S. to serve on civic boards and commissions.

At United WE, we have big plans for 2024. And, we know it takes diligence, patience, and passion to get where we're going. Thank you for your ongoing support and dedication to our mission. Together, we will keep making strides that advance all women.




